<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Place the possessive apostrophe accurately in words with regular plurals and in words with irregular plurals
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Investigate writing similar to that which they are planning to write in order to understand and learn from its structure, vocabulary and grammar
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● To be able to write a extended narrative piece- creating settings, characters and plot
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● To propose changes to grammar and vocabulary to improve consistency, including the accurate use of pronouns in sentences

<ul style="list-style-type: none">● To read aloud my own writing, to a group and the whole class, using appropriate intonation and controlling the tone and volume
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Use the present perfect form of verbs in contrast to the past tense
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Choose nouns or pronouns well for cohesion and to avoid repetition
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Indicate possession by using the possessive apostrophe with plural nouns
